# Congregational Forum

#### MAY CONGREGATIONAL FORUM—Wed., May 4, 7pm

There will be three main action items that the members of ECOB will need to address at this forum. As always, there will be meetings, in advance of the forum, for input to happen (both inperson and online) on all of these items. First, it has been 5 years since the bylaws were updated—it is common practice to update at

this time. The updates suggested by the Leadership Team will be shared at the March 22 meeting (see below). Second, the church budget. A budget meeting will be held on April 12 (see below) for comments, suggestions and concerns. Finally, we will be voting on Pastor Ryan's interim status as Interim Associate Pastor of Discipleship. In addition, it is possible that we will vote on a ministry candidate, Tom Strubel, if all of the District process is complete by that time. There will be an opportunity to have conversations with both Ryan and Tom as they discern these next steps in ministry. Again, we provide meetings (see meeting dates/times below) for conversation before our meeting so that the meeting itself can happen effectively and efficiently. We look forward to an engaging opportunity with all those who attend ECOB.
