- 4) A unanimous affirmation of Tom Strubel to be licensed to ministry
- 5) A 93.5% affirmation of Ryan Burkholder to become an Associate Pastor at ECOB. Ryan has affirmed that vote.



Eleanor Isaacson Eleanor grew up in Hitler's Germany. Separated from her parents at age 2, she experienced the war and the Nazi Regime first-hand. She arrived in the United States alone in 1948 at the age of 13.

"I never heard of God. I never saw a Bible. I never heard of Jesus. I never saw a cross. Hitler didn't like people going to church." Instead, she referred to God as her "invisible friend," and vowed to "find him" if she survived. It was the first of what she calls the three turning points in her spiritual life.
