I was attending Love Feast because it was what I was supposed to do. She was attending out of a deep desire to be more like Jesus. I had known Jesus for 49 years. She had known him for less than 1 year. But God used HER to teach ME. If I had to name the most pivotal moment in my walk with Christ, it would be that Love Feast. I could name a bunch of ways God has used the people He is bringing to ECOB to grow my understanding and faith this year. They are ways I never could have imagined. Of course I couldn't have imagined them, they are God's ways! As we reflect on the past 125 years of ECOB, in addition to fondly remembering our traditions and heritage, I'd encourage us all to look for the ways God is moving today. Because we just might be surprised how much more He has for us to learn and do!
