We are currently in the last months of the Beyond the Building Campaign – a campaign that was developed to help us fund the needed renovations to the church in 2020. Here is the great news – in the 5 years of this campaign, we have paid over \$1,000,000 off in our expenses, leaving us with a little under \$2,000,000 left to go. Yes, that is over 1/3 the way there! Praise God – we celebrate God's faithfulness, and your faith-filled sacrificial generosity to accomplish a milestone. As we look to paying down the remainder of the loans we have, we will be giving the congregation an opportunity to give, above and beyond their normal tithes, to help close that mortgage as soon as we can. There will be more information to come in the next months; however, we want to encourage you to begin praying for how we can, as a church, continue the amazing ministry we have currently - and - lower our mortgage moving forward. We will be revealing how you can participate in a variety of ways in the newsletters and mailings to come. In the meantime, know that God is doing amazing things here, as one person shared, "The Holy Spirit is moving at ECOB – how you have opened your church, share your gifts, and been a blessing in Ephrata is inspiring."
